Invited are proposals for Visiting Scholars (VS) who are known to be good speakers and who are willing to

- stay in Switzerland for about two weeks (or longer if it can be organised and financed by the local host)
- visit two of the NCCR PlanetS locations in Switzerland
- present a series of research lectures accessible for interdisciplinary PhD students and junior scientists (and senior staff) in Planetary Science. (Potentially, a mini-workshop on an appropriate topic associated with the VS can be organised.)
- informally meet with young scientists (separately from the faculty) to share experience and answer questions about a professional/career development topic of the VS's choice.

Procedure

- Maximum budget per VS: 3300.- provided by the AP
- Reminders sent out to everyone (by the AP coordinator) to suggest VS
- AP coordinator collects suggestions and forwards them to the Steering Committee
- Steering Committee makes decision and determines host for the VS
- Host invites VS
- If VS accepts, the administration at the host's institute organises the logistics/travel arrangements
- If VS accepts, AP coordinator contacts VS to arrange professional development meeting with students
- After visit by VS, the reimbursement associated with the VS is done by Suzanne Wilde.
